Quilted Jacket Supply List

For the jacket you will need a total of 12 Fat Quarters (for larger size XXL you will need 15 Fat Quarters). The Fat quarters need to play well together. For my jacket I used 6 different fabrics (2 Fat Quarters of each color), but you can use 12 different fabrics if you would like.

Please organize the Fat Quarters into 2 sets of 6 Fat Quarters (or 3 sets of 5 Fat Quarters if you are making the larger size).

I like to use the extra fabric for my jacket binding, but if you would like your binding all the same color you will need ½ yard of fabric.

You will also need a Sweatshirt that is one size larger than you normally wear. (Ex-if you wear a Medium, please purchase a large sweatshirt). Please make sure the sweatshirt has set in sleeves (not raglan). A good

brand to purchase is Glidan crew neck sweatshirt. I buy mine <u>here</u>.

Thread to match your fabric for sewing and quilting. Sewing machine in good working order and walking or quilting foot.

- -Scissors
- -Cutting mat, ruler and rotary cutter with new blade
- -Pins or Wonder Clips
- -Safety Pins
- -Ink pen


