Splash of Color 2024 Cabarrus Quilters Guild Quilt Show Quilt Show Rules and Entry Form

- 1. Entry forms must be received no later than Monday, May 13, 2024
- 2. Each entered item must have its own entry form.
- 3. To submit an entry, please bring your completed entry forms to our April or May Guild meeting or mail the completed forms to Debra Mills, 1034 Owen Blvd, Charlotte, NC 28213. NOTE: When possible include a picture of the quilt with the entry form but the picture must be turned in no later than submission of quilt.
- 4. Entry Fee: for CQG members the fee is \$10 for the first quilt, additional quilts are \$5 each. For Non-CQG members the fee is \$15 for the first quilt submitted, \$10 for each additional quilt. No fee for Youth, Challenge, or Display Quilts.
- 5. Member Entrants must be Cabarrus Quilters Guild (CQG) members in "good standing" for the 2024 year (2024 dues paid and 2023 charity quilt submitted (if member in 2023).
- 6. All entrants may enter any number of quilts, limited to two judged quilts per category. There are unlimited entries in category 3700 Display Only, based on space available.
- 7. Entry must have three (3) layers (top, middle, and backing). Entry must be quilted, not tied, with the following exceptions: crazy quilts, yo-yo quilts, cathedral window quilts, home décor and wearables. Quilting is defined as a running stitch that passes through top, middle layer, and backing.
- 8. All quilts entered must be in good condition, odor free, clean and free of dirt and animal hair. It is the right of the Judging Committee to refuse any entry.
- 9. Muti-piece quilt items, such as table runners in multiple pieces, should be pinned at top edge of each piece to a piece of black fabric that is 2 inches larger than the whole quilted item. Measurement for the entry form is for the backing fabric but must indicate how many pieces are in the set.
- 10. The Quilt Show Committee and/or judges reserve the right to divide or combine categories and to move entries to a more appropriate category.
- 11. Quilts need to have been completed after January 1, 2020, and may not have been previously judged in the CQG show.
- 12. Quilts in category 3100 Art Quilt may not contain copyrighted images.
- 13. Quilts that have won a prize in a national competition (e.g., AQS, Mancuso, Quilt Odyssey, Quiltcon, etc) may be submitted **For Display only** and will not be judged.
- 14. All quilts must be labeled with the label being sewn on the lower left-hand corner of the quilt back (as you face the back of the quilt). The label should include the name of the quilt, the maker's name and year made.
- 15. All quilt labels must be covered at the time of entry with a small piece of muslin <u>pinned, secured</u> <u>with a running stitch or painter taped</u> over them so that the identity of the maker will not be known to the judges.
- 16. All quilts must be submitted by Tuesday June 11, 2024 between 1 pm and 6:30 pm. Drop off location will be: Harrisburg Presbyterian Church, 4815 State Hwy. 49, Harrisburg, NC 28075. Mailed entries can be mailed to Debra Mills, 1034 Owen Blvd, Charlotte, NC 28213 and must be received no later than Saturday, June 1, 2024.
- 17. The show is located at West Cabarrus High School, 4100 Weddington Rd, Concord, NC 28027
- All quilts must be picked up after the show on Saturday, June 29, 2024. We will do our best to have the quilts ready at 5:30 pm. All quilts will be processed before any quilt can be picked up. <u>No</u> <u>exceptions.</u>
- 19. Entries will NOT be returned by mail.

DEFINITIONS

- Solo Quilts made entirely by one person, i.e., pieced, quilted and bound by the maker.
- **Duet** Quilts completed by two persons. Includes all quilts that have been quilted by someone other than the piecer.
- **Bed Quilt** Intended for use on a bed.
- Wall Hanging Intended for display on a wall.
- **Stationary Machine** Process of moving the fabric through the sewing machine, regardless of domestic or longarm machine.
- Movable Machine Process of moving the machine on a track, regardless of domestic or longarm machine.
- **Computer Guided (Movable) Quilting** All quilting completed using a track mounted machine using a computer program to control the pattern.
- Hand Guided (Movable) Quilting All quilting completed using a track mounted machine guided by hand to accomplish free motion or ruler quilting.
- Quilting by Embroidery Machine Quilting of the layers of the quilt is performed by an embroidery machine.
- Splash of Color Defined as spot or pop of color on a monochromatic background.

CATEGORIES

- 1100 Solo Large Bed Quilt Large Bed Quilts have a width of 80 inches or greater.
- **1200 Solo -Small Bed Quilt** Small Bed Quilts have a width less than 80 inches and include lap quilts and baby quilts.
- **1300 Solo -Large Wall Hanging** –Large Wall Hangings have a perimeter equal to or greater than 144 inches.
- **1400 Solo Small Wall Hanging** Small Wall Hangings have a perimeter less than 144 inches.
- **1500 Solo Youth Quilt** Any quilt made by someone 19 and under. The maker does not need to be a member to enter. No entry fee.
- **1600 First Quilt** First Quilt completed by someone with less than three years of quilting experience and no previous quilt show entry. First quilts may be professionally quilted. Limited to one entry. If more than one entry, cannot submit for this category. Any size.
- 1700 Splash of Color Quilts must reflect the theme of our show Splash of Color. Any size
- 2100 Duet Large Bed Quilt Large Bed Quilts have a width of 80 inches or greater.
- **2200 Duet Small Bed Quilt** Small Bed Quilts have a width less than 80 inches and include lap quilts and baby quilts.
- 2300 Duet -Large Wall Hanging –Large Wall Hangings have a perimeter equal to or greater than 144 inches.
- 2400 Duet Small Wall Hanging Small Wall Hangings have a perimeter less than 144 inches.
- **2500 Duet Youth Quilt** Any quilt made by someone 19 and under. The maker does not need to be a member to enter. The Quilt may be professionally quilted. No entry fee.
- 2600 Group Quilt Quilt that three (3) or more people were involved in making the top. Any size or style.
- **3100 Art Quilt** Quilt that is an original design and made solely by one person. No commercial patterns. Non-traditional pieced or mixed media such as embellishments, paints, Angelina hair, beads, paper, thread paint, etc. are used in the construction of the quilt. Made as an expression of art.
- **3200 Miniature Quilt** All aspects of the quilt are reduced in scale with no side larger than 24 inches. A miniature quilt is not a quilt block with borders, but a quilt with all the components of their larger counterpart. A photograph of a miniature quilt should look as though it was a photo of a full-sized quilt. Quilts that do not meet the requirements will be moved to the wall hanging category.
- 3300 Specialty Quilts Whole Cloth, Yo-Yo, Cathedral Window, and Crazy Quilts.
- **3400 Wearable** / **Home Decor** Must be two (2) or more layers and contain some quilting and may have embellishments such as beading, felting or embroidery. Items include jackets, vests, coat or a full ensemble, baskets, tree skirts, stockings, table runners, potholders, etc.
- 3500 Bags, Totes must be three (3) layers and contain some quilting and have handles for carrying.
- **3600 Challenge Quilt** -- Quilts for the current year's guild challenge must be entered in this category following all rules of the challenge. No entry fee, limit one per member.
- **3700 Display Only** This can be a quilt of any size or type but will not be judged. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries in this category if space is an issue. No entry fee.
