## Cubed Project:

Star 60 -- Use the Capped 60 Technique Sheet to make the Cubed project. Inspired by the book Big Book of Building Block Quilts by Sara Nephew -- Honeycomb Waffle 2 pattern


Make 9 cubes by creating 18 half hexagons to create the center.

Fabrics: Cap 60 units

| Light | $1 / 3$ yard | (3) $23 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips |

| Medium | $1 / 3$ yard | (3) $23 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips |
| Dark | $1 / 3$ yard | (3) $23 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips |

Half Triangles:
Background
1/2 yard
(1)5 1/2" x WOF strip
Medium/Dark
3/4 yard
(1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip
Borders:
$\begin{array}{ll}\text { Background } & \text { (4) } 2 \text { " x WOF strips } \\ \text { Medium/Dark } & \text { (4) } 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times \text { WOF strips }\end{array}$

Approximate 35" x 35"
Kits* will be provided day of the workshop: Star 60 tool and Capped 60 Technique Sheet $\$ 44.00$ includes a $25 \%$ discount plus taxes and rounded.

Description: This class uses the Star 60 tool along with a Technique Sheet from Studio 180 Design to create the cubes to make this 3-D sampler. It is important to have a good contrast with each of the light, medium and dark fabrics you choose to achieve the illusion. Small scale prints or blenders work best for the color values. You can take a picture on your phone and edit with filter to black/white or grey scale. This will let you know if you have the correct values from your fabrics.

Equipment and Supplies Basic sewing including a sewing machine with accurate $1 / 4$ " seam. Other: cutting mat, rotary cutter, small iron, pressing stick for open seams, 100\% cotton thread 50 wt ., seam ripper, pins. Invisgrip for the back of the Star 60 tool highly recommended.
