Scraps 4-1/2"Squares	25
Background 7-3/4" squares	4
Background 3-1/2-inch Squares	16
Background 4-1/2" Squares	20

Sewing machine, spare needles, 1/4" foot, standard foot

Thread and bobbins filled at home

Rotary cutter and small mat Marking pencil, Thread snips, pins 6-1/2" square ruler or larger Wing clipper (optional) Iron and press mat
